## Message Notes for July 15, 2018

1 Peter (Week 09) - Healing Your Hidden Wounds (1 Peter 4:1-8)

Since therefore Christ suffered in the flesh, arm yourselves with the same way of thinking, for whoever has suffered in the flesh has ceased from sin, so as to live for the rest of the time in the flesh no longer for human passions but for the will of God. For the time that is past suffices for doing what the Gentiles want to do, living in sensuality, passions, drunkenness, orgies, drinking parties, and lawless idolatry. With respect to this they are surprised when you do not join them in the same flood of debauchery, and they malign you; but they will give account to him who is ready to judge the living and the dead. For this is why the gospel was preached even to those who are dead, that though judged in the flesh the way people are, they might live in the spirit the way God does. (1 Peter 4:1-6, ESV)

### 1. Learn to \_\_\_\_\_ like Jesus.

And Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do..." (Luke 23:34)

See to it that no one fails to obtain the grace of God; that no "root of bitterness" springs up and causes trouble, and by it many become defiled. (Hebrews 12:15)

### 2. Seek to do God's \_\_\_\_\_ instead of what you feel.

So as to live for the rest of the time in the flesh no longer for human passions but for the will of God. (1 Peter 4:2)

"Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted." (Matthew 5:4)

For the time that is past suffices for doing what the Gentiles want to do, living in sensuality, passions, drunkenness, orgies, drinking parties, and lawless idolatry. (1 Peter 4:3)

With respect to this they are surprised when you do not join them in the same flood of debauchery, and they malign you... (1 Peter 4:4)

but they will give account to him who is ready to judge the living and the dead. (1 Peter 4:5)

For this is why the gospel was preached even to those who are dead, that though judged in the flesh the way people are, they might live in the spirit the way God does. (1 Peter 4:6)
